RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLE WILL BE SERVICED ON THE SAME DAY AS TRASH SERVICE

CO-MINGLED

Glass: consisting of clear and colored bottles

Plastics #1-#7: plastics that are recyclable have a triangle on the bottom of the container with a number inside.

Aluminum and tin: (please remove all food product from the tin cans)

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN CO-MINGLE:

Drinking glasses, windshields, window panes, mirrors, and vases. Aerosol cans (hairspray, cooking spray, whipped cream...etc)

PAPER PRODUCTS

Newsprint

Magazines

Paperboard—cake boxes, cereal boxes, soda & pop boxes, beer cartons.

Cardboard—waxed and unwaxed • 4 feet x 4 feet is the largest size and it must be “broken down” or cut down and flattened with all packaging materials removed. Please place under the bin.

Allowable Plastics

PLASTIC #1

PET or PETE (Polyethylene terephthalate)



Found in: soft drink, water and beer bottles; mouthwash bottles; peanut butter containers; salad dressing and vegetable oil containers; ovenable food trays

PLASTIC #2

HDPE (High density polyethylene)



Found in: milk jugs, juice bottles; bleach, detergent and household cleaner bottles; shampoo bottles; some trash and shopping bags; motor oil bottles; butter and yogurt tubs; cereal box liners

PLASTIC #3

V (Vinyl) or PVC



Found in: window cleaner and detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, cooking oil bottles, clear food packaging; wire jacketing, medical equipment, siding, windows, piping

PLASTIC #4

LDPE (Low Density polyethylene)



Found in: squeezable bottles; bread, frozen food, dry cleaning and shopping bags; tote bags; clothing; furniture; carpet

PLASTIC #5

PP (Polypropylene)



Found in: some yogurt containers, syrup bottles, ketchup bottles, caps, straws, medicine bottles

PLASTIC #6

PS (Polystyrene)



Found in: disposable plates and cups, meat trays, egg cartons, carry-out containers, aspirin bottles, compact disc cases

PLASTIC #7

Miscellaneous



Found in: three- and five-gallon water bottles, 'bullet-proof' materials, sunglasses, DVDs, ipod and computer cases, signs and displays, certain food containers, nylon

Recyclables:

- Co-Mingles: #1-7 Plastic (no PVC)
- Mixed color glass bottles and jars (no ceramic mugs or plates)
- Aluminum cans and foil
- Tin (steel) cans
- NO books or telephone books
- Cardboard is accepted if broken down, **separated** and no larger than 3 foot by 3 foot bundles.
- Newspaper, magazines, paperboard are excepted – however – please have them separate from your co-mingle - off to the side or on top with a rock so they don't blow away.
- If paper is mixed into the recycle, the driver will not pick it up, and leave it as contaminated for the garbage man.
- Recycles are picked up weekly. Note that the garbage and recycles are picked up by two different trucks.
