Dear Town of New Castle Residents,

We would like to thank the Town of New Castle for choosing MRI (Mountain Roll-offs, Inc.) for your trash and recycling service.

Your trash and recycle will be picked up weekly on Wednesday. Please have your trash/recycle out on the curb by **7am**.

Co-mingle recycle is #1-7 plastics, glass, aluminum, tin, placed in recycle bin. Please bundle your newsprint and cardboard/paperboard (cereal boxes, beverage boxes) separately and place on top of or to the side of the other recyclables. Cardboard cannot be bigger than 3feet by 3feet and needs to be "broken" down (flattened) with all packing material removed, no more than 6 boxes per pickup. Cardboard must also be free of wax (milk cartons, perishable food boxes). We cannot pick up your recycle if it is contaminated with trash, if it is it will be disposed as trash.

With regard to holidays, trash pickup will be one day late (Thursday) when a major holiday falls on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday (the Holidays we observe are Memorial Day, Labor Day, 4th of July, Thanksgiving, Christmas Day and New Years).

The dues collected by the Town of New Castle will cover the cost of picking up a 96 gallon trash container (68 gallon for seniors) and one 18 gallon recycling container. If you need an additional container please call our office at 876-5900. If you have trash in excess of the 96 gallon we will pick up and charge the below prices. For extra household and yard waste it is \$7.50 for every 1/2 yard extra and \$15.00 for every yard extra. These extras will be billed to the resident directly.

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

RESIDENTIAL RECYCLE WILL BE SERVICED ON THE SAME DAY AS TRASH SERVICE

CO-MINGLED

Glass: consisting of clear and colored bottles

Plastics #1-#7: plastics that are recyclable have a triangle on the bottom of the container with a number inside.

Aluminum and tin: (please remove all food product from the tin cans)

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN CO-MINGLE:

Drinking glasses, windshields, window panes, mirrors, and vases. Aerosol cans (hairspray, cooking spray, whipped cream...etc)

PAPER PRODUCTS

Newsprint

Magazines

Paperboard—cake boxes, cereal boxes, soda & pop boxes, beer cartons.

Cardboard—waxed and unwaxed • 4 feet x 4 feet is the largest size and it must be “broken down” or cut down and flattened with all packaging materials removed. Please place under the bin.

Allowable Plastics

PLASTIC #1

PET or PETE (Polyethylene terephthalate)



Found in: soft drink, water and beer bottles; mouthwash bottles; peanut butter containers; salad dressing and vegetable oil containers; ovenable food trays

PLASTIC #2

HDPE (High density polyethylene)



Found in: milk jugs, juice bottles; bleach, detergent and household cleaner bottles; shampoo bottles; some trash and shopping bags; motor oil bottles; butter and yogurt tubs; cereal box liners

PLASTIC #3

V (Vinyl) or PVC



Found in: window cleaner and detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, cooking oil bottles, clear food packaging; wire jacketing, medical equipment, siding, windows, piping

PLASTIC #4

LDPE (Low Density polyethylene)



Found in: squeezable bottles; bread, frozen food, dry cleaning and shopping bags; tote bags; clothing; furniture; carpet

PLASTIC #5

PP (Polypropylene)



Found in: some yogurt containers, syrup bottles, ketchup bottles, caps, straws, medicine bottles

PLASTIC #6

PS (Polystyrene)



Found in: disposable plates and cups, meat trays, egg cartons, carry-out containers, aspirin bottles, compact disc cases

PLASTIC #7

Miscellaneous



Found in: three- and five-gallon water bottles, 'bullet-proof' materials, sunglasses, DVDs, ipod and computer cases, signs and displays, certain food containers, nylon

Recyclables:

- Co-Mingles: #1-7 Plastic (no PVC)
- Mixed color glass bottles and jars (no ceramic mugs or plates)
- Aluminum cans and foil
- Tin (steel) cans
- NO books or telephone books
- Cardboard is accepted if broken down, **separated** and no larger than 3 foot by 3 foot bundles.
- Newspaper, magazines, paperboard are excepted – however – please have them separate from your co-mingle - off to the side or on top with a rock so they don't blow away.
- If paper is mixed into the recycle, the driver will not pick it up, and leave it as contaminated for the garbage man.
- Recycles are picked up weekly. Note that the garbage and recycles are picked up by two different trucks.

Frequently Asked Questions About Your Trash and Recycling Services

Our contact for trash and recycling is with Mountain Roll-Offs, Inc. or MRI

* Please call (970) 876-5900 or use MRI's website – www.mrico.net for any of the questions below

- 1) Can I order a smaller or larger trash container?

Answer: Yes, you can order a 32, 64 or 96 gallon trash container. If you're not satisfied, you can re-order within 60 days. Contact MRI to order.

- 2) Can I obtain a lid for my recycling bin?

Answer: MRI is currently out of stock, but they should be in stock soon. Contact MRI to order.

- 3) *What are MRI's recycling services?

Answer: MRI provides one 18 gallon blue recycling bin for co-mingled recyclables which includes:

- i. Plastics #1 - #7
- ii. Glass
- iii. Aluminum and tin

You can contact MRI for an additional 18 gallon yellow recycle bin at no charge. It is for:

- iv. Newspaper
- v. Office paper
- vi. Magazines, catalogs, and phone books
- vii. Paperboard (cake boxes, cereal boxes, soda boxes, and beer cartons)
- viii. Cardboard (need to flatten and place under recycle bin)

*Additional recycle bins are available for \$10.00. Contact MRI and they will bill you separately

- 4) Occasionally, MRI throws some recyclables in the trash and does not recycle some of my products. Why?

Answer: There could be a couple of reasons why this happens. There could be too much contamination and/or the driver made an error. For assistance, contact MRI.

- 5) I forgot to leave the trash/recycle bin outside on Wednesday before 7:00 A.M.; can I contact MRI to pick up either?

Answer: If MRI trash and recycling trucks are in the area on the same day of your Wednesday pick-up, they will assist you. Contact MRI for help.

6) How do I dispose of tires, batteries, small appliances, motor oil and tree branches?
Answer: Call MRI for a special pick-up at no additional charge. Please call by 3:00 P.M. on the Tuesday before regular trash/recycle pick-up on Wednesday. Tree limbs must be bundled and must be no longer than 4 feet long and no greater than 2 and one-half inches in diameter.

7) How do I dispose of *electronic waste?
Answer: For an additional 50 cents per month, MRI can be contacted to dispose of the following items:

*Additional charge of \$10.00 for any size TV with broken tubes

- Cell phones
- Microwaves
- Computer towers
- Keyboards
- Laptop computers
- Kitchen appliances
- Rechargeable tools

* These items can be picked up on the First Thursday of each month by calling MRI at least 48 hours in advance. Contact MRI for detailed information.

8) I left my trash container and recycle bin outside by 7:00 A.M. and they didn't pick up one or the other. Why?

- Answer:** There could be a few reasons why this happened. They are:
- i. There was a holiday on the Monday before Wednesday trash/recycle pick up. For example Christmas and New Years Eve in 2013 falls on a Monday. Trash/recycles will be picked up on Thursday.
 - ii. Trash/recycle trucks do break down and may be late.
 - iii. Although this is very rare, the driver may have forgotten.
