Subject: Elk Creek Campground Bridge

Tom,

The Public Works Department's use of the bridge at the Elk Creek Campground is minimal. During the summer months the maintenance crews utilize the bridge two or three trips a week. Vehicle traffic does increase during the coldest winter days to seven trips a week. During the winter, it is necessary to access the property more often, in order to clear ice from the raw water inlet. The type of vehicles that we operate over the bridge are restricted to light trucks only. We do not operate heavy equipment or heavy truck traffic over the bridge.

The Public Works Department is happy to offer the property owners with number of potential considerations for the use of their land/infrastructure. We are willing to provide snow removal services for the portion of the property that we access. We can assist with noxious weed control. We can provide gravel materials to help with the reconditioning of the road surface.
