

On March 23, 2015, Seth Graby, as owner of the Silver Club Saloon (hereinafter the "Saloon") was personally served a Notice of Hearing and Order to Show Cause for three alleged violations of law; Colorado Liquor Regulation § 47-900, New Castle Municipal Code § 9.24.070, and New Castle Municipal Code § 8.08.030(A). These alleged violations arose from an incident reported by Jeff Ellis, a neighboring homeowner. Mr. Ellis alleged that on or about March 16, 2015, a fight occurred outside of the Saloon, in an alley adjacent to Mr. Ellis' home and the Saloon. The incident involved two males and one female party. Mr. Ellis also reported a single glass beer bottle had been found in is yard, as well as several extinguished cigarette butts around his firewood storage area. A hearing on these allegations was held on April 7, 2015. Jarrad Pierce attended on behalf of the Saloon, as manager. Testimony was heard from Jeff Ellis, Police Chief Pagni, Jerad Zelenka, Ben Allen, and Jarrad Pierce. After consideration of the testimony presented, the Saloon was found to be in violation of Colorado Liquor Regulation § 47-900 and New Castle Municipal Code § 8.08.030(A). A suspension of 7 days was handed down.

To remedy the situation leading to the violations of law, the Saloon took remedial action during the suspension period, as well as continuing efforts to the present time. The Saloon has purchased and is planning to install, in the immediate future, a security door with an alarm in the back patio area of the Saloon. This door will keep patrons inside the designated area and if they try to exit into the alley area, an alarm will sound, alerting bar personnel. Further, the Saloon has purchased and is planning to install, in the immediate future, a CCTV system to allow bar personnel to monitor patrons throughout the Saloon to ensure no patrons become unruly. In the back patio area, there are several cigarette disposal receptacles, as well as signage indicating that used cigarette butts are to be disposed of in said receptacles.

The Saloon has the following procedure for unruly patrons. If a patron appears to be intoxicated, the bar tender will offer them a water or other non-alcoholic drink, as well as making an effort to secure a safe ride from other patrons. If the patron becomes unruly, they are asked to leave, and if need be, are escorted out by bar personnel. If the patron refuses to leave, the police are called. The bar tender also keeps a detailed report of all incidents in a notebook behind the bar. The Saloon takes steps to have all bar personnel trained in the TIPS Certification program. Training for TIPS Certification is currently scheduled for September 23, 2015, at the Saloon. Training is to be conducted by Tom Regan Consulting. Since the Saloon opened in 2012, there have been ten citations to patrons of the Saloon.

The Saloon is ready and willing to work with its neighbors and the Town of New Castle to ensure that no further incidents occur in the future.

## MEMORANDUM

RE: Liquor License Renewal Standards

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The Town Council should renew a liquor license unless it finds “good cause” for not granting the renewal.

“Good cause” for a non-renewal means the following under State law:

- (a) The licensee has violated, does not meet, or has failed to comply any of the terms, conditions, or provisions of this article or any rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this article.
- (b) The licensee or applicant has failed to comply with any special terms or conditions that were placed on its license in prior disciplinary proceedings or arose in the context of potential disciplinary proceedings.
- (d) Evidence that the licensed premises have been operated in a manner that adversely affects the public health, welfare, or safety of the immediate neighborhood in which the establishment is located, which evidence must include a continuing pattern of fights, violent activity or disorderly conduct. “Disorderly conduct” has the same meaning as provided for in section 18-9-106, CRS.

“Disorderly conduct” means:

Making a course and obviously offensive utterance, gesture, or display in a public place, when the utterance, gesture, or display tends to incite an immediate breach of the peace; or

Making unreasonable noise in a public place or near a private residence that the person has no right to occupy; or

Fighting with another in a public place except in an amateur or professional contest of athletic skill; or

Discharging a firearm (subject to exceptions for police, hunting, target practice, or firing blanks a funeral for a veteran); or

Displaying a deadly weapon or any article used or fashioned in a manner to cause a person to reasonably believe that the article is a deadly weapon, or representing verbally that one is armed with a deadly weapon in a public place in a manner calculated to alarm.

## **Hearing Procedures**

Council convenes as the Liquor Authority.

Open public hearing.

Ask anyone wishing to testify to raise their hand and swear to tell the truth (say “I do”)

Staff presents its report and findings.

Applicant presents any information and responds to staff presentation.

Public comments.

Applicant response to public comments.

Council questions to Applicant, Staff, or Public.

Close public hearing.

Deliberation and decision.

## **Actions and Conditions of Approval**

The Liquor Code does not provide clear authority to impose conditions on a license renewal. However, the applicant may include certain representations and promises in the application itself such as installing cameras, signs on exits, TIPS classes, etc. The Council can and should engage in a discussion with the applicant about these and other measures that may be taken to mitigate neighborhood concerns and past transgressions. Anything the applicant states on the record of the public hearing becomes part of the “application” and is therefore binding upon the applicant.

Following the close of the public hearing and appropriate deliberation, the Council should vote either to approve or to deny the renewal application.

Rather than voting for a “conditional approval,” the Council should make it clear that any vote of approval is relying on the statements and representations made at the hearing and in the written materials, and the minutes should reflect such matters specifically. Our office will work with the Town Clerk following the hearing to ensure that the minutes accurately reflect any such matters.

To whom it may concern,

I conducted a records search of incidents and cases involving the Silver Club Saloon, located at 366 W. Main Street, from October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014 to present day. I found a grand total of 68 incident numbers, and 10 cases were written which originated from the Silver Club Saloon.

Most of the incident numbers were a result of routine bar checks or some type of follow-up. There were 16 reported incidents involving noise complaints, drug investigations, liquor/alcohol violations, disturbances, trespasses, suspicious events, and hazards.

Of the 12 cases that were pulled

Case #14N0406 occurred on 10-21-2014 and involved an unreported disturbance/criminal mischief inside the bar. There was a disturbance involving three bar patrons fighting or nearly fighting with each other. One bar patron allegedly fled the bar from the other two bar patrons who were threatening him and called 911. On 11-05-2014 the bar owner, Seth Graby, complained to an officer that his pool table had been damaged and nothing was being done about it. Mr. Graby was advised that something could have possibly been done, had the incident been reported at the time by the bar.

Case #14N0456 occurred on 12-07-2014, and involved a physical altercation between the bar owner, Seth Graby, and a bar patron. Mr. Graby admitted to punching the bar patron, but was not charged due to conflicting statements from other bar patrons.

Case #14N0464 occurred on 12-13-2014 and involved a minor child (approx. 12 years old) being allowed into the bar on a busy Saturday night, playing pool with approximately 40 other bar patrons while alcohol was actively being served.

Case #14N0461 occurred on 12-14-2014 and involved an intoxicated bar patron being loud and aggressive with an officer on a routine bar check. The bar owner, Seth Graby, was notified of the intoxicated patron and refused to address the problem, allowing the intoxicated patron to remain in the bar.

Case #14N0489 occurred on 12-28-2014 and involved over service of a bar patron that ended up falling down and injuring himself, requiring ambulance transport to the hospital.

Case #15N0093 occurred on 03-16-2015 and involved a disturbance in the unmonitored lounge area in the back area of the bar, which went unreported by the bar, as required. The bar owner, Seth Graby, was very uncooperative with the responding officer when asked what the suspects looked like. Mr. Graby responded by saying "they are like all the town's residents with arms and legs." Mr. Graby was charged in that case with failing to report disorderly conduct and public nuisance.

Case #15N0096 occurred on 03-17-2015 and involved another fight between a bar patron, the bartender, and the bar owner, Seth Graby. The bar patron was charged with disorderly conduct based on witness statements.

Case #15N0122 occurred on 04-18-2015 and involved a female bar patron who was trespassed from the establishment at the request of the bar.

Case #15N0267 occurred on 08-01-2015 and involved the sale of alcohol during prohibited hours (after 0200).

Case #15N0323 occurred on 09-13-2015 and involved the theft of a cell phone inside the bar, by an underage person who allegedly presented a fake ID. The underage person was served alcohol by the bar.

Case #15N0333 occurred on 09-24-2015 and involved a Silver Club patron allegedly fighting with a female party in the alley behind the bar. The intoxicated male party had a warrant for his arrest, and was combative with the arresting officer. The male party was arrested for the warrant, as well as for obstructing and resisting arrest. The bartender did assist the arresting officer in some capacity.

Case #15N0297 occurred on 08-30-2015 and involved a DUI traffic accident. The arrestee was a patron of the bar that night, and had been reportedly "choked out" by the bar owner, Seth Graby. Witnesses reported the arrestee and Seth Graby had been engaging in horseplay. The arrestee's blood alcohol level is not yet available, pending the results of the blood test.

On 09-03-2015 at approx. 2218 hrs Officer Polen and Dominguez made contact with the bar on a noise complaint. There was a band playing, the bar was warned and asked to keep the door closed.

On 09-04-2015 at approx. 2306 hours, I received a noise complaint about the bar. They were again playing very loud music and leaving the front door of the establishment open. I had to ask/remind the bartender to keep the front door of their establishment closed to contain some of the noise. I also observed the back gate which accesses North Alley from the Silver Club Saloon remains unlocked allowing access to the bar from the alley way, and to the best of our knowledge the rear patio area of the bar remains unmonitored.

On 09-20-2015 at approx. 0005 hrs, I received another noise complaint about the bar. I parked across the street and listened to the loud music coming from the bar. After a minute or two, I was observed sitting across the street and the door was closed.

On 09-26-2015 at approx. 2211 hrs, Cpl. Burrows and Officer Polen received another noise

complaint. The front door was again open, and the bar was advised again to keep the front door closed. The bar owner, Seth Graby, told Officers “What about the fucking train? That thing is loud as shit!”

Dear Tom,

We wish to make you aware that noise coming from the Silver Club on 366 Main Street is disturbing us to such an extent that it is affecting the enjoyment of our home is an public nuisance. In light of their license renewal we would ask that some adjustments will get discussed and/or implemented in the operation late at night and in the early morning hours while live and/or loud music is played.

Most all weekends, some weekdays in July and August and so far the weekends in September a loud live music is played until 2 am. On September 11, 2015 music could be heard on and off until 4:00AM.

Bar doors are kept propped wide open while the music plays creating a live music concert on public sidewalk and streets blasting into our 2<sup>nd</sup> floor apartment. Our building is across a main highway at least 90 feet away from the bar but the noise is so loud it makes it impossible to sleep or enjoy our home while the bar doors are kept open. Even with all our window closed the noise is simply too much to sleep.

Bar customers commonly hang outside the bar entrance smoking, both pot and cigarettes, hooting, hollering and throwing cigarette butts into the street into the wee hours of the morning. No one seems to obeying any type of smoking laws or showing any consideration to anyone in the neighbourhood. On and off you can smell pot most recently on September 12, 2015 from 3 people standing by the front door at 1:15am. I am not sure if the town has any specific rules regarding openly smoking pot on public streets.

On many occasions during the 3 months, we have owned this property, we have noticed inebriated customers stumbling out driving away in their cars or on their motorcycles. This does tends to happen later at night.

We are not against having live music or having the bar operate within town laws and regulations. However, it should be contained within their establishment not creating major noise disturbances for neighbours. We have several, video clips, recording after 1:00AM, showing people, hanging-out, right in front of the main entrance and the massive noise we have to experience, inside our apartment. The police has come by asking them to keep noise down but that only lasts for an hour by them closing the door but then the doors are propped open again and it starts over.

I looked into the code for the town and see that Town has noise level statue per the state CRS Section 25-12-103. <http://www.nonoise.org/lawlib/states/colorado/colorado.htm>. This statue states any noise above 55 decibel in commercial zones between 7pm-7am is considered a public nuisance. This should be a calculation is based on 25 feet from source of nuisance. Please correct me if I am not reading this correctly.

I went ahead and started measuring the noise level and last night (September 19<sup>th</sup> 2015) and it was consistently 65-85 decibel. I stood inside my living room while I measured. This is a measurement more than 90 feet away from the source of the noise, making this way above being acceptable. When they keep their door closed the noise goes down to a reasonable level.

It is only reasonable to require the establishment to have the music contained by keeping the door closed at all times during live concerts and supplying their customers with an area where they can smoke, whatever they smoking, away from public sidewalk and streets.

Dear Tom....I am writing to you to express my concerns for living next door to the Silver Club Saloon. It is not good Tom, and it is getting old. My husband Ed and I came from a pristine farm setting in Western New York. Ed's dream all his life was to live in the West. We sold everything we had... (3 farms and all that went with them, 2 houses, a car and anything else we couldn't fit into our truck)...we came to New Castle to help Molly and Jeff with their new business and to start our new life. I will tell you some of the antics we have to live with:

Walking with my daughter-in-law and 2 year old grandson past the Silver Club, we were witness to a patron vomiting in the outdoor trash receptacle.

All our doors and windows must be closed at night and we are forced to run the AC to drown out the noise and loud music. We'd love to open the windows for the nightly mountain air, but we can't.

At night, patrons from the Silver Club gather under the awning right below our bedroom window. they smoke and we smell it, they fight, and we are awakened by it. Sometimes the fighting is scary, we don't feel safe. We have called the police, but that is getting old too. Nothing really happens on their end, (by the time they get here the commotion is often over) and the nonsense keeps happening at this end!

The partying out behind the place is LOUD....and they are out there all the time.

Last night we witnessed someone pulling in behind the bar, with music so loud it rattled the windows, A young man got out...lit up a joint...sat in the car and smoked it and then drove away. We were out on the roof observing the solar eclipse and the Blood Moon. We saw him light up the joint before he got into his car.

When we first moved here...we heard a loud fight in the night, and in the a.m. on the way to church , we saw bloody footprints coming out of the Silver Club and disappearing around the corner.

There has been vomit and feces on the sidewalk out front.

Not to mention the stress we have felt for the kids, as Molly and Jeff had to deal with their car being stolen and totaled, their jeep being ransacked, and people just pulling into their parking spot to go to the bar.

Recently we were awakened in the night by someone being arrested out back and by our back gate. When we have guests, this type of event is embarrassing and also we don't feel safe. Many nights we lose sleep and have to get up for work in the morning. Family and friends from back home are beginning to wonder why we chose this town to live! Family and friends come to visit us and we want to show them our town, but the first place they see is that hole-in-the-wall.

We have tried to be neighborly (by that I mean, polite and courteous), but it is not reciprocated.

Now I see that their liquor license is up for renewal. If any of you good folks on the Administrative Board can do anything to deny them this privilege, we would be so grateful. Maybe it would force them out of New Castle. We would love to see a nice bar happen there...like the kind of place that the Black Dog is. A nice bar would be great for the town...pool tables, food, sports on TV, nice clientele...we are not against a bar....we just HATE THAT BAR. We are getting too old to spend our last chapter next door to that place. There are too many concerns on our part for our quality of life here. Please consider the nice people that are moving into New Castle and the message that awful place is sending.

Hi Tom

Attached is the readouts from Last night September 26th. The sound increased as the night went by. This was even louder than the weekend before. We are about 90 feet away so these are levels way above the maximum levels of 55 dB at 25 feet.

We did notify the police and saw that owner and bar manager got a message on their phone as they were standing on the sidewalk. About 20 minutes after that we saw them quickly close the door as two police officers came walking towards the bar. They had a quick conversation with the owner and then walked away. As soon as they left the owner opened the window on the door so the noise carried outside again. By 12:30am the doors were wide open yet again. They don't seem to be taking complaints seriously ignoring the requests to keep the door closed and the noise down. We have spoken to several neighbors and there are similar stories and complaints about noise, trespassing and unfortunately criminal activity by some of the guests. This has gotten to the point that people are not feeling safe.

We will keep informing you of what we see and hear going on there, in order to help everyone get a clearer picture of the situation, and help the council in determining what action is appropriate.
