A REQUEST FROM : THE NEW CASTLE CUB SCOUTS, PACK 221

To: THE TOWN OF NEW CASTLE

Our pack has successfully gathered about 30,000 pound of food for Lift Up over the past 6 years. Pretty amazing for a community of 4,000 people. Looking into it future I found that the most food donated in 24 hours was in Durham, North Carolina. 559,885 pound. However, they have a population of 251,893 people, and in the metro area 542,710. I submitted an application to the Guinness Book of World Records for "the most food donated by a community in 24 hours, per capita. our event will be 24 hours from Saturday November 12th at 1:00pm until Sunday November 13th at 1:00pm In the past we have collected about 6,000 pounds of food in 2 days. This year we hope to at least collect 14,000 pounds of food, or about 4 pounds per person (4,500 x 4). My request to you, is that we would like to get 6 banners 30"x96" (\$45x6= \$270), 10 yard signs at about \$100, and 50 posters at about \$75. So, about \$500 is what we need. Your consideration and support would be appreciated. Additionally, we will need as accurate as possible a census count, along with lots of support and promotions.
