Re: Council Agenda for November 1st Meeting

Purpose: The purpose of this memorandum is to summarize the agenda item as most items will be in the form of PowerPoint presentations or handouts at the meeting.

Fire Chief Rob Jones: Chief Jones is the newly appointed Fire Chief for the Colorado River Fire Rescue. Chief Jones asked to come to Council and introduce himself. The Town and Fire District have a very good working relationship and Chief Jones is here to continue to build that relationship.

Jeff Simonson: Two years ago Jeff gave Council a presentation of CDOT's 2025 and 2040 plans as they pertain to the I-70 interchange and the intersections that have an impact on the interchange. We have recently had discussions with CDOT regarding the US 6/CVB roundabout and potential grant funding for the I-70 interchange work. Staff and Jeff want to bring Council up to date on recent information regarding the interchange project and take feedback on the Town's role in funding a portion of this effort.

Garfield Clean Energy (GCE): Each year GCE requests funding for the work that do for the county and town. GCE staff will give Council an update on work to date and work program assignments for 2017. The draft 2017 budget considers GCE funding remaining steady with 2016.

Roaring Fork Mountain Bike Association (RFMBA) and New Castle Trails (NCT): RFMBA and NCT will give Council updates on the work they are undertaking in town, on BLM land and in South Canyon.
